b. Timeline

The committee agreed that the timeline for the ad hoc working group is unknown at this time.

c. Plan

Dr. Ryan stated that the working group was established at the rand review data on post tenure processes from INDUS institutions. He explained that during legislative session, there were some preliminary discussions regarding tenure taking place.
