HIST260 Women in America

Women in America from pre-colonial times to the present. Focuses on experiences of typical women of the past, including minorities.

HIST261 American Indian History

Survey of Native American history, emphasizing diversity of historical experience. Themes include cultural persistence, leadership and activism, and strategies adopted by Indian communities for coping with change.

HIST270 Native American Studies

A multicultural study of American minority groups that concentrates on North Dakota Native Americans and gives special attention to African and Mexican Americans.

NAS 201 History of the Three Affiliated Tribes

Examines The Mandan (Nueta), Hidatsa (Nuxx baaga), and Arikara (Sahnish), known collectively as the Three Affiliated Tribes, with European encounters from the age of Columbus through the end of the early modern period.
